Exploring Richmond

The Lanes & Richmond Green

Brewers Lane. Paved Court & Golden Court contain a wonderful collection of small independent shops and cafes. This is the perfect place to locate that 'hard to find' gift - anything from beautiful jewellery, books and award winning chocolate to specialist tea and coffee, high quality menswear, ladies fashion and the best ice cream in London. Explore the area around Richmond Green to find the ruins of Richmond Palace and its surviving gateway and the beautiful 19th Century theatre.

Eton Street, Red Lion Street & Sheen Road

Explore this part of town and discover some great places to eat, from French to Italian, Spanish to Japanese. Browse the many specialist stores offering cookware to comics, toys to tailoring. Meander down Church Walk and you will find more interesting shops and restaurants, as well as St Mary Magdalene Church, parts of which date back to the 16th Century.

George Street, The Quadrant & Kew Road

Enjoy relaxed shopping among all the great names you expect in the high street, intermingled with some lovely independent shops and cafes. Head along Kew Road towards Old Deer Park to discover London's only permanent theatre in the round as well as some great family sport & leisure facilities.

Richmond Hill & Village

Just a short walk from the hustle and bustle of the high street, the Hill offers many wonderful independent shops, including galleries, fashion boutiques, antique shops and gift shops - not forgetting Richmond's smallest pub. At the top, pause to take in the breathtaking view over Petersham Meadows before you relax and revive yourself in the cafe society that is Richmond Village on Friars Stile Road.

Richmond Bridge

Richmond has the oldest bridge spanning the Thames in London. Make sure you walk across this beautiful 18th Century stone arch structure and look back at Richmond and Petersham Riverside. You may also get a glimpse of the local boat builders who played a major part in the construction of the Gloriana for the Queen's Diamond Jubilee.

Richmond Riverside

Head off the beaten track down Water Lane to the Riverside. On the way you will find a great art house cinema and some lovely traditional English pubs, where you can sit and watch the world go by.

Petersham Road & Riverside




